



the Pranic healing method on a female participant who had complained about persistent knee pain and went back with relief. Participants were also given tips on meditation and gave some


demonstration which was shared by all present.





India after more than 60 years of freedom just has less than 0.7% of world tourism share & in

ADTOI elects New Treasurer and Joint Secretary

the upcoming GST Council Meet to bring down the 28% peak GST rate for hotels & restaurants. Additionally, the Finance Minister and the Revenue Secretary have also been met with by multiple stakeholders and have been requested to reconsider this 28% rating following their stated GST principles of equivalence and competitiveness. We are updating you till now what actions have been taken. Mainstream & trade Media have been widely reporting the issue. All CMs, FMs, TM, CS, RS & TS have been sounded on the issue. Commerce Ministry, Tourism Ministry & Prime Minister's Office have been requested to intervene on this issue with Ministry of Finance. Tourism Minister personally spoke to FM & gave him a complete representation. PM personally took the matter up very concerned & has been explained the irrationality on the rate by the Secretary Tourism. **GST UPDATE** Under the GST rate slabs, hotels/ inns/ campsites/ guest houses/ similar commercial establishments/ lodging with a rate of above Rs.5000 has been classified as luxury & put under a newly created bracket of 28% for services. For consumption in restaurants in a property which is classified as 5star & above, the GST rate has been pegged at 28%.
